
New Orleans Men's Circle Spring Retreat April 5-7, 2024 King's Arrow Ranch

The Journey

There are mountains, mountains already crossed, mountains yet to cross, mountains to be avoided. There are rivers, some so small they can seemingly be stepped across almost effortlessly, but some with depths that no man knows. But the journey can also be on the vast trackless sea, and from islands can sometimes come songs sweeter than any ever heard, the fulfillment of all desires. WHEN

The dates for the retreat are April 5th, 6th, and 7th of 2024. Arrive Friday, April 5th. On-site registration and bunk assignment will begin by 5 p.m. Please plan to arrive no later than 5:30 P.M. Dinner will be available at 6 P.M., and our opening ceremony will begin at 7 PM. You may arrive as early as you wish on Friday to check out the grounds, hike, meditate, or spend some time in nature. The retreat will end after lunch on Sunday.

WHERE

King's Arrow Ranch, Hillsdale, MS, just east of I-59 North at exit 35, 75 miles north of New Orleans and 30 miles south of Hattiesburg, MS. In case of emergency, you can be reached through the King's Arrow Ranch phone # 601-796-3423. You will be asked to avoid use of your cell phone during the Retreat.
